- \* Add a brief bibliography of the author(s) on a second page.

The standard time limit for paper presentations is 20 minutes, with 10 minutes for questions.

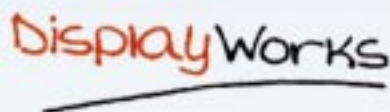
